

## Dog Daycare General Information and Policies

The purpose of The Total Dog and a Little Cat is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs during weekday business hours. To ensure the safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following rules and regulations:

**AGE:** All dogs must be at least 12 weeks of age or older.

**SEX:** All dogs 12 months or older must be spayed or neutered.

**SHOTS:** All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must provide written proof of DHLPP and Bordatella vaccinations. Rabies is required for puppies over 4 months of age.

**HEALTH:** All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.

**BEHAVIOR:** All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will verify their dogs have not harmed or shown aggressive threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern

**APPLICATION:** All dogs must have a complete, up-to-date and approved application on file. There is a one-time \$10.00 non-refundable application screening fee for each pet.

**FEES:** Fees are based on a pass plan. A pass is valid for 12 months from date of purchase.

1-day pass:	\$19.00
10-day pass	\$171.00 (one day free)
20-day pass	\$323.00 (three days free)

Multiple dog discounts available.

**DAYS AND HOURS:** Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and there is a \$1.00 per 3 minutes charge for any pet left after 6:30

**RESERVATIONS:** Required. Cancellations with less than 24 hour notice will be charged full fees.
